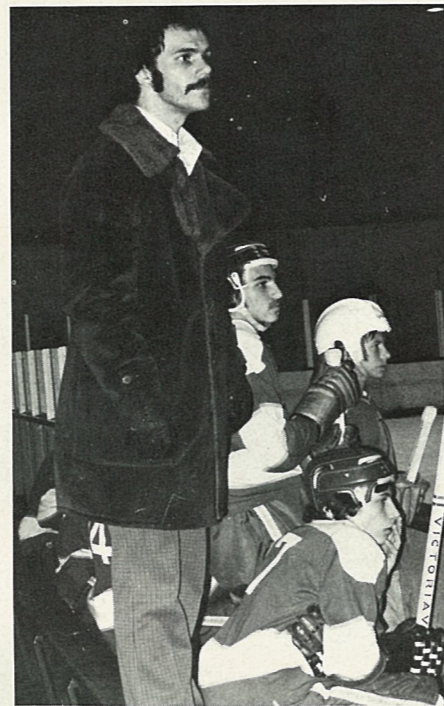

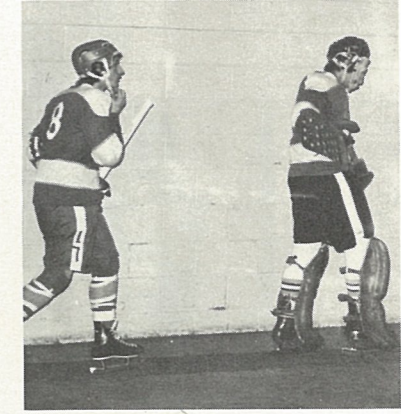

At the end they didn't quite make it but during the season the Kennedian team was feared. Thanks girls!



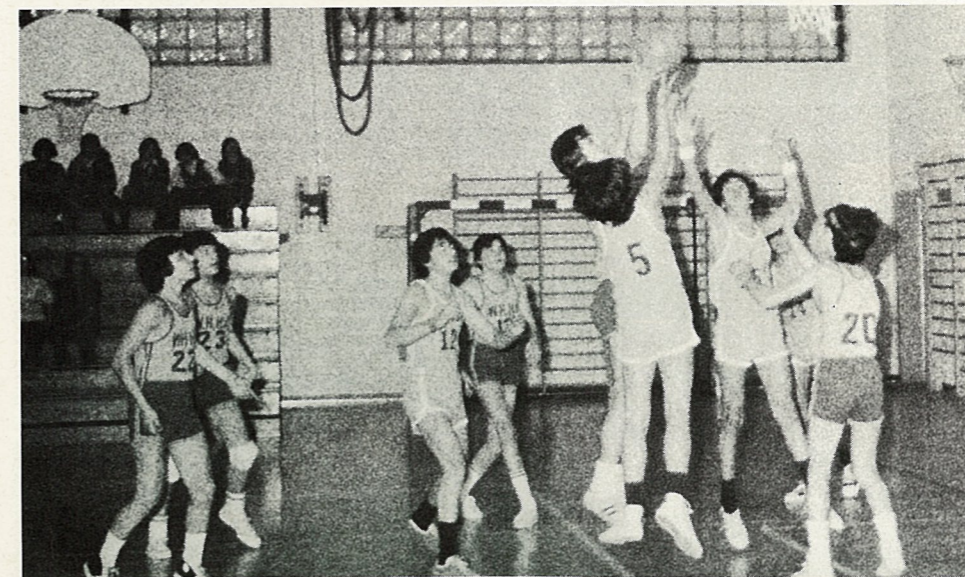
# BOYS' BASKETBALL

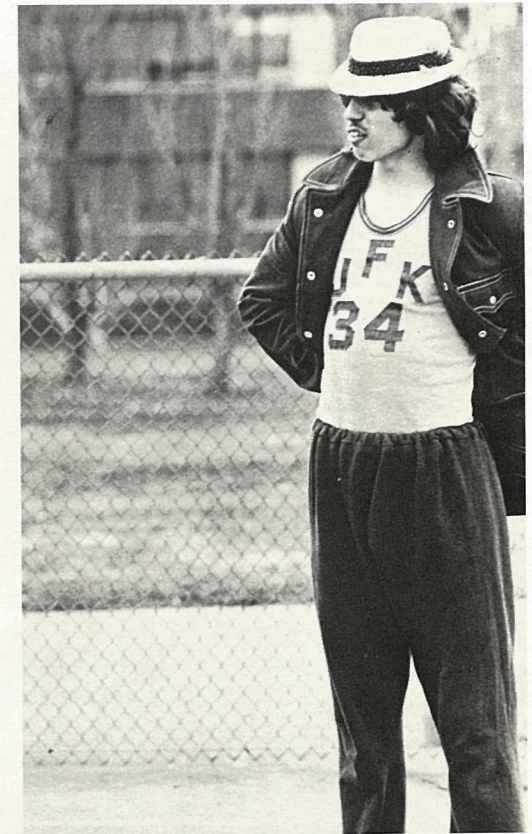

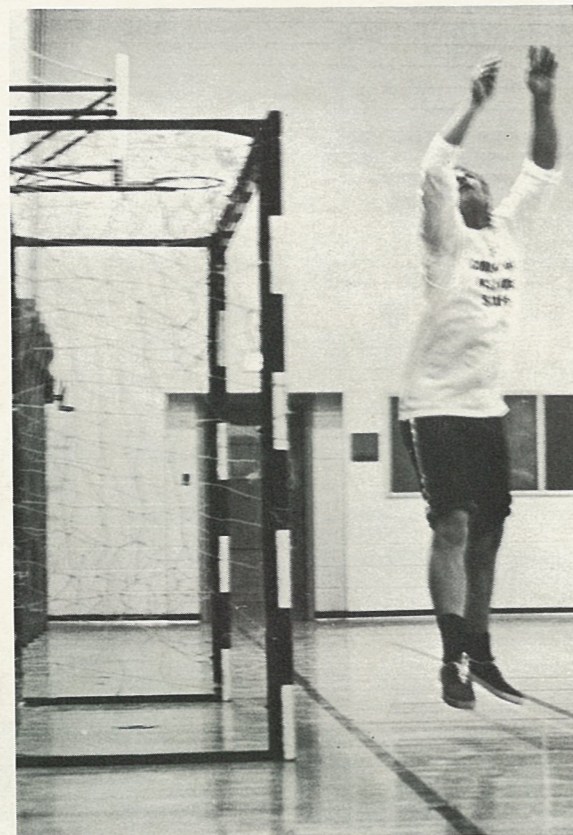

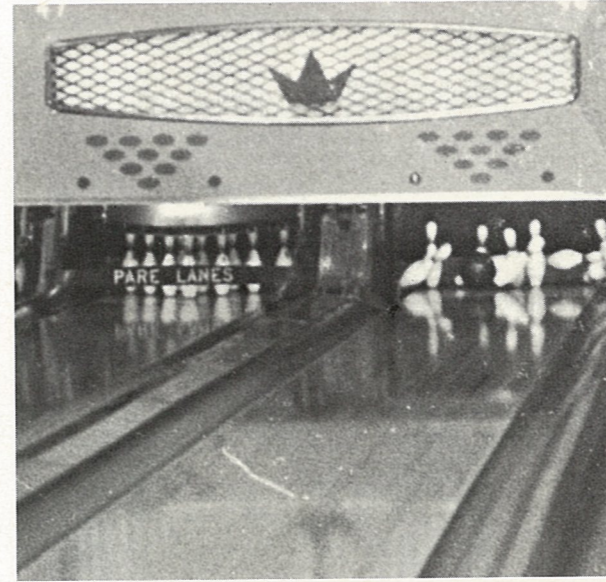

# POP FESTIVAL



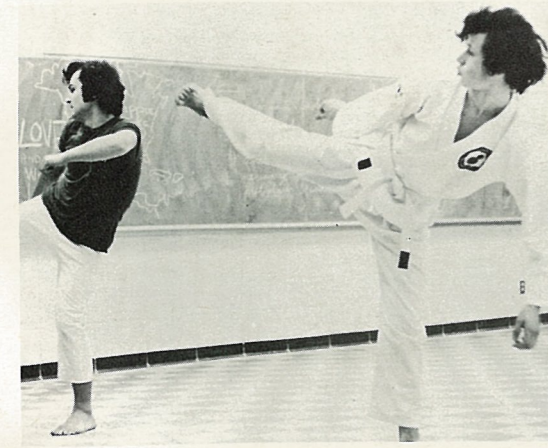
The pop festival was an extra event this year at J.F.K. The variety of music and the appearance of "Elvis Presley" gave the show an extra touch of exoticism.

Self-defence is what the karate club is all about. This is a great activity and club for everyone interested in the Japanese cult of self-defence.



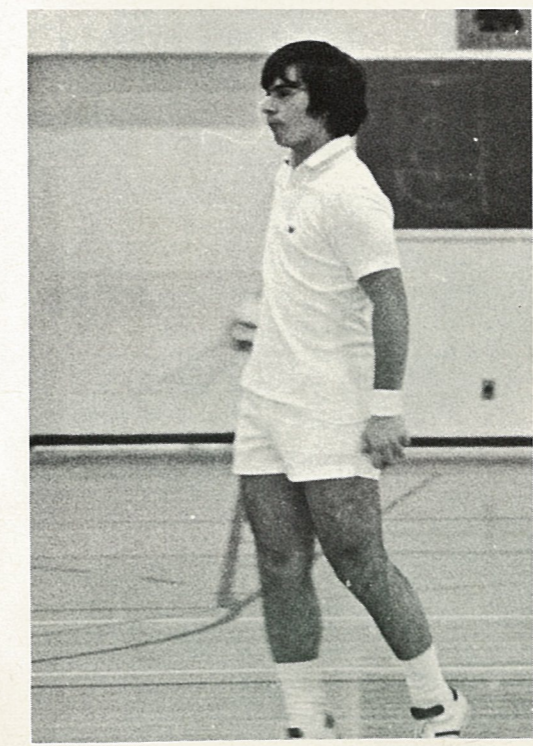

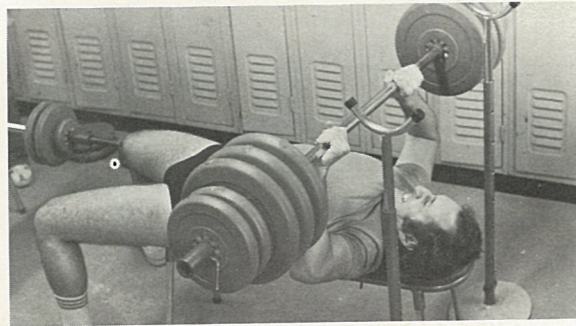
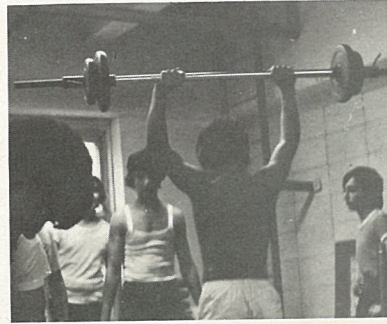

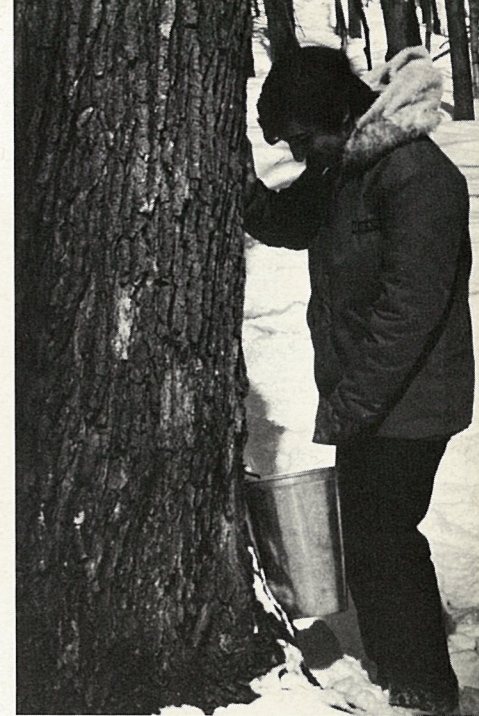

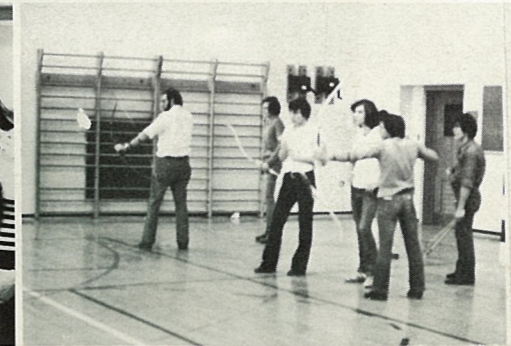
